Applied Business (Ba) Grade 4 or above in both GCSE English Language and Maths. GCSE Business Studies, Business V-Cert or BTEC First Award in Business are preferred, but not essential. An APS of 4.25 or above is required.	Photography (Ap) Grade 5 or above in a GCSE Art and Design subject and Grade 4 or above in GCSE English Language and GCSE Mathematics. Taking Core Maths as an enrichment is recommended for students taking this course. An APS of 4.5 or above is required.	Classical Civilisation (Cl) Grade 6 or above in a GCSE History or Ancient History. Grade 6 or above in GCSE English Literature and Grade 4 in GCSE Mathematics. To study Classical Civilisation, students do not require any previous knowledge of a Classical subject, or knowledge of Classical Greek or Latin language. An APS of 4.75 or above is required.	Spanish (Sp) Grade 6 or above in GCSE Spanish. Grade 4 or above in GCSE English Language and GCSE Mathematics. Students will be also interviewed by a language teacher in Spanish and English. An APS of 4.75 or above is required.	Business Studies (Bs) Grade 5 in both English Language and Maths. GCSE Business Studies qualification preferred, but not essential. Taking Core Maths as an enrichment is recommended for students taking this course. An APS of 4.5 or above is required.
Biology (Bi) Grade 6 or above in both GCSE Biology and GCSE Chemistry, or Grade 7/6 in Combined Science. Along with Grade 6 or above in GCSE Mathematics. An APS of 5.5 or above is required.	Drama (Dr) Grade 5 or above in GCSE Drama (or equivalent). Grade 4 or above in GCSE English Language and Mathematics. An APS of 4.25 or above is required.	Childcare & Education (Ce) Grade 4 or above in GCSE English Language and GCSE Mathematics. Any student meeting the Sixth Form entrance criteria is eligible for this course.	Chemistry (Ch) Grade 6 or above in GCSE Chemistry along with a Grade 7/6 in GCSE Combined Science. Grade 4 or above in GCSE English Language and Grade 6 or above in Mathematics. An APS of 5.5 or above is required.
Computing (Cs) Grade 5 or above in GCSE Computer Science (or programming equivalent). Grade 5 or above in both GCSE English Language and Mathematics. An APS of 4.5 or above is required.	Geography (Gg) Grade 5 or above in GCSE Geography. Grade 4 or above in GCSE English Language and GCSE Mathematics. An APS of 4.75 or above is required. Health and Social Care (Single) (Hc) Grade 4 or above in GCSE English Language and Mathematics. Any student meeting the Sixth Form entrance criteria is eligible for this course.	English Language & Literature (Ll) Minimum Grades 5/6 for GCSE English Language and GCSE English Literature in any combination. Grade 4 or above in GCSE Mathematics. An APS of 4.75 or above is required.	History (Hi) Grade 6 or above in GCSE History or Ancient History. Grade 5 or above in GCSE English Language and Grade 4 or above in GCSE Mathematics. An APS of 4.75 or above is required.	Health and Social Care (Double) (Hd) Grade 4 or above in GCSE English Language and Mathematics. Any student meeting the Sixth Form entrance criteria is eligible for this course. (If choosing Health and Social Double – please also choose Health and Social Single in block A, as this is half of the double qualification).
English Literature (Li) Grade 6 or above in GCSE English Literature, Grade 5 or above in GCSE English Language and Grade 4 or above in GCSE Mathematics. An APS of 4.75 or above is required.	Mathematics (Ma) Grade 7 or above in GCSE Maths. Grade 4 or above in GCSE English Language. An APS of 5.5 or above is required.	English Language & Literature (Ll) Minimum Grades 5/6 for GCSE English Language and GCSE English Literature in any combination. Grade 4 or above in GCSE Mathematics. An APS of 4.75 or above is required.	Physical Education (Pe) Grade 6 or above in GCSE Physical Education (or equivalent). Grade 6 or above in GCSE Mathematics and/or a GCSE Science. Grade 4 or above in GCSE English Language. High level performance in a sport will also be considered. APS of 4.75 or above is required.
Media Studies (Ms) Grade 5 or above in GCSE English Language and Grade 4 or above in GCSE Mathematics. An APS of 4.5 or above required. Media Studies (Ms) Grade 5 or above in GCSE English Language and Grade 4 or above in GCSE Mathematics. An APS of 4.5 or above required.	Musical Theatre (Pm) Any student meeting the Sixth Form entrance criteria is eligible for this course. However, applicants must be able to demonstrate significant experience in 2 from acting/singing/dancing – this could include GCSE Drama/Dance or Music at Grade 5 or above, or equivalent. An APS of 4.25 or above is required.
Psychology (Py) Grade 5 or above in GCSE English Language, in addition to a Grade 6 or above in GCSE Mathematics and/or GCSE Science. An APS of 4.75 or above is required.	Sociology (So) Grade 5 or above in GCSE English Language. Grade 4 or above in GCSE Mathematics. An APS of 4.75 or above is required.	Music (Mu) Grade 5 or above in GCSE Music (or equivalent). The ability to read music notation and sing/play an instrument to Grade 5 level or above is required. Grade 4 or above in GCSE English Language and GCSE Mathematics. An APS of 4.25 or above is required.	Sociology (So) Grade 5 or above in GCSE English Language. Grade 4 or above in GCSE Mathematics. An APS of 4.75 or above is required.
Religious Studies (Rs) Grade 5 or above in GCSE English Language and Grade 4 in GCSE Mathematics. There is no requirement to have studied the subject previously. An APS of 4.5 or above is required.
